



Nappy Changing Procedure

- Involve the child: Collect the nappies and wipes, talk about what's going to happen, respect the child's fears as teachers will be lifting the child to a higher place other than the floor e.g nappy changing pad.
- Talk to the infant/toddler through changing, treating this as a special time
- Support older children in removal of nappy to sit on toilet, respecting the right to privacy
- Always wear gloves when changing soiled nappies
- Remove soiled/wet nappy and dispose of into nappy bin
- Never leave a child unattended
- Dress child, then return them to their choice of play area
- After changing, wipe down mat with a diluted disinfectant then dispose these, along with gloves, into nappy bin
- Record nappy/toileting time and what motion happened onto the whiteboard
- Wash your hands before changing another child
